

Overview

- Hiring: One Public Relations Coordinator
- Capital Outlay: N/A

2. Law Enforcement and First Responders

o **Amount:** \$300,000

- **Description:** Equip law enforcement and first responders with naloxone and provide training on overdose response.
- Hiring: N/A (training for existing personnel)
- o Capital Outlay: Purchase of naloxone supplies and training equipment
- Vehicle Purchases: N/A

Total Funding and Distribution

- Q1 2024: Launch prevention programs and public awareness campaign
