Opioid Settlement Funds Implementation Plan

July 2024 - June 2025

Overview

In 2022, the State of Florida, and Local Governments engaged in the litigation seeking to hold Pharmaceutical Supply Chain Participants accountable for the damage caused by their misfeasance, nonfeasance and malfeasance. The State and Local Governments were to use the awarded monies to increase the amount of funding presently spent on opioid and substance abuse education, treatment and other related programs and services.

The City's current Opioid fund balance is around \$41,606 including interest.

The City of Greenacres intends to utilize their portion of the opioid settlement funds in alignment with the requirement of Schedule B.2: Approved Uses-Law Enforcement and First Responders.

Funding Allocation

The City of Greenacres provides ambulatory/Fire Rescue service. The funds will be used to purchase Nalozone (and associated PPE's), training for new employees and continuing training for current employees, educational drug pamphlets, and preventative education within the local schools.

Monitoring and Evaluation

Regular monitoring of the Nalozone inventory is currently being conducted and will continue. This will assist in monitoring the need. Training classes will be done around April of 2025.

Conclusion

Through public awareness and education, the City of Greenacres aims to reduce the opioid crisis in our community.
