 - **Amount:** \$193,452.49
 - **Description:** Support specialty courts including drug and mental health court in the 19th judicial circuit for Martin County.

2. **Training**
 - **Amount:** \$10,000
 - **Description:** Funding for staff training to improve the capability of Martin County to abate the opioid crisis.
